WHANGANUI

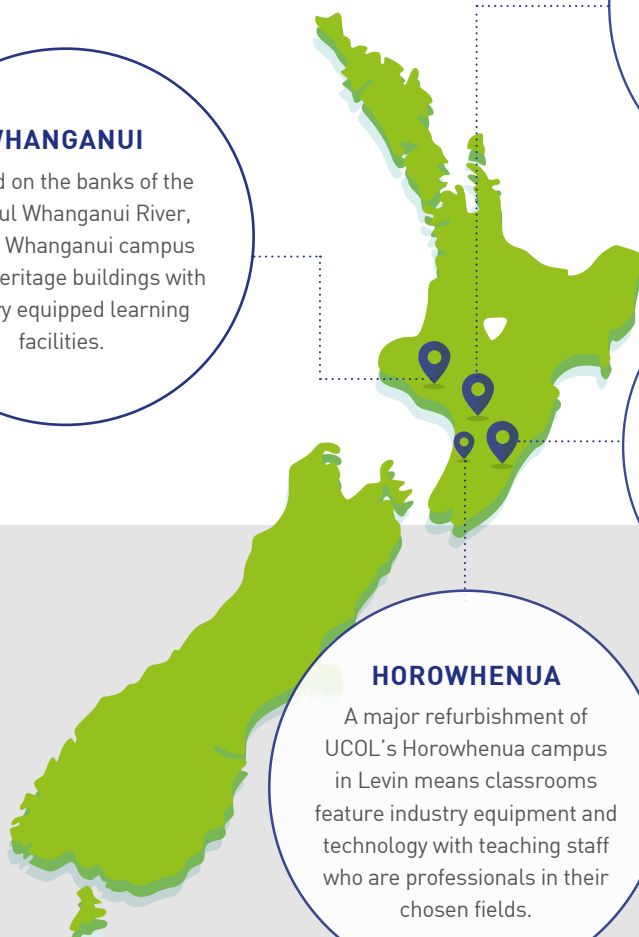
Located on the banks of the beautiful Whanganui River, UCOL's Whanganui campus blends heritage buildings with industry equipped learning facilities.

Complete, sign and send your international student application along with all required certified documents. You can send this to us via email or post.

03 Application Assessment

UCOL will assess your application to ensure you meet all the requirements.

04 Offer of Place

If your application is successful you will be sent an Offer of Place. You can now accept your Offer of Place.

05 Apply for your Student Visa and Pay your Fees

Apply for your student visa. When you receive your 'Approval in Principle' offer, you can pay your fees using the information provided on your Offer of Place.

06 Plan for your arrival

Once your visa has been approved it's time to plan for your arrival! Please send us your travel arrangements so that we can pass these on to our International Student Support Staff who will help organise your pick-up upon your arrival in New Zealand.
